



## The VITTA Video Challenge - Terms and Conditions

The rules and guideline listed below are also the terms and conditions of entering The VITTA Video Challenge.

1. All entries must be registered via The VITTA Video Challenge website
2. All entries must be posted to VITTA (Suite 209, 134-136 Cambridge St Collingwood VIC 3066) by **5pm, Friday 18 May 2012**.
3. Videos that are predominantly non-animation must be about 3 minutes in length and video that are predominantly animation must be at least 1 minute in length but no longer than 3 minutes. Opening title and closing credit sequences may sit outside these time restrictions.
4. Most production must occur in the first week of May 2012. Final rendering, titling, exporting and burning may occur after this deadline.
5. Only 1 entry per school per category (Primary - Prep to Year 6, Junior Secondary – Year 7 to Year 9 & Senior Secondary – Year 10 to Year 12) will be accepted. Your school may like to run their own film festival to decide which entry will be represented in each category.
6. All entries must be equivalent to a G rating. All content should be very mild in nature and appropriate for all ages.
7. Each entry must feature the secret object in **most** scenes and the secret phrase as dialogue or text.
8. Most of the writing, filming, acting and editing must be done by students within the category age range.
9. All soundtracks must be from a copyright free source.
10. Films are to be submitted as a full-quality file (.avi or .mov) via a data DVD, CD or USB stick preferably in 16:9.
11. VITTA reserves the right to disqualify any entrant whose entry does not comply with these Terms and Conditions, or who submits content which is not deemed appropriate.
12. Each entry must have an opening title sequence that names the video and the school as well as a closing sequence that lists all the students' first names only and the teacher/s in charge.

13. All submitted entries need to clearly be labelled with the name of the school, the age category and the name of the video.
14. Decisions from the panel of judges are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Any judge who represents a school that has an entry must not take part in the judging of those entries.
15. VITTA can accept no responsibility for entries lost, delayed, misdirected, damaged or undelivered. Incomplete and/or illegible entries will be disqualified. Any contact details entered incorrectly on the website shall be deemed invalid and will result in an ineligible entry.
